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## **Code of Conduct for BPMS Learners**

1. To attend classes daily, on time and all homework to be done.
2. To be in possession of appropriate stationery, e. g. Pencil, pen, ruler etc.
3. To respect all adults, fellow students and property.
4. To refrain from abusive language.
5. To protect school property and also refrain from removing material or school property.
6. To refrain from disruptive undisciplined or uncooperative behaviour inside and outside the classroom.
7. To adhere to the dress code by wearing the correct uniform daily.
8. Not to leave the school premises during the course of the day without permission from the principal.
9. Not to destroy or deface any textbook, writing book or any school property.
10. To refrain from the use of tobacco, drugs, liquor, carrying dangerous weapons, bullying, or being in possession of pornographic material.
11. To greet and speak politely to educators, learners and visitors.
12. To move quietly and sensibly about the school (no running)
13. Always keep left on the corridors, be quiet and listen attentively in assemblies.
14. Always keep the school clean and tidy by not littering, keeping furniture clean and unmarked.
15. Off school premises, remember the school reputation depends on the way you behave.
16. To refrain from victimization, intimidation, discrimination, polarization and vandalism.
17. Adhere to class rules
18. No fighting or shouting.
19. No swearing or personal attacks.
20. No stealing.
21. No unlawful trading may take place on the school grounds.
22. No contact sport.
23. Report suspicious persons to the nearest teacher.

24. Report potentially dangerous objects that could injure a learner.
25. Respond immediately to the bell indicating the end of break. Walk swiftly to the assemble area without running.
